WORD FROM THE PASTOR

A voice says, "Cry out."
And I said, "What shall I cry?"
"All people are like grass,
and all their faithfulness is like the flowers of the field.

The grass withers and the flowers fall, because the breath of the LORD blows on them. Surely the people are grass.

The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever." *Isaiah 40:6-9*

April showers brings May flowers or at least that is how the saying goes. The rainy season in April may be at times a tad miserable and cold when we are hoping for Spring but without it, we would not have the new life that comes in May. I love May flowers, the tulips and lilies sharing their beauty with us. My only complaint is that I wish they would last longer.

The passage from Isaiah is in between scripture you may know as they are quoted frequently. Before it is the passage about preparing a way for the Lord that the New Testament refers to with John the Baptist and after it is the passage about those who wait on the Lord will renew their strength and be lifted up. 
