WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Happy February Andover!

As I prepare for the perfect square month (28 days, 4 weeks, no remainders) I think of the work we have put into serving our community in one month. Over 300+ hours of service, connection, and care is something to rejoice in. It makes me think of a passage from Philippians:

I thank my God every time I remember you, ⁴ constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, ⁵ because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. ⁶ I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ. ⁷ It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. ⁸ For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the compassion of Christ Jesus. ⁹ And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight ¹⁰ to help you to determine what is best, so that in the day of Christ you may be pure and blameless, ¹¹ having produced the harvest of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God.

I use this passage often in newsletters because Paul communicates so well how I feel about the faith communities I have the privilege to serve. I thank God every time I remember the 16500 meals we prepared last summer. I thank God when I remember how our church answered the call for refugees. I thank God when I remember the kits, yard work, and service we have shared with the Sunlight house. I thank God when I remember the number of hours we are giving into our community so that it is known that there is a people that care and a God that loves.

What I have always loved about Paul's intro to Philippians is the unwavering and encouraging confidence that their good work will bring to completion. I hope this is true for us as well. I don't just mean the 6000 hours of service. The number of hours are a valiant goal to strive for like the number of meals we prepared but the good work I am thinking of is a spiritual work. May we know the love of God in Christ Jesus, that we are called regardless of what we have done or what has been done to us and are welcomed into both the God's grace and Jesus mission through the Holy Spirit. I hope this spiritual work will continue on to completion until each of us realize that we are Jesus' mission. That our words are God's and our actions are Jesus' as the Holy Spirit guides us to live out our faith. I pray that this holy and sacramental work continue in each of us. I am excited to continue striving for 6000 hours but my hope and confidence is that even one minute serving or connection with our neighbor continues the good spiritual work in us and in our neighbor.


QCC-Qualified Charitable Contribution

A Qualified Charitable Contribution (QCC) is a NON-TAXABLE distribution from an IRA that is owned by an individual who is age 70 1/2 or older. The Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is paid directly by the trustee of the IRA to an organization eligible to receive tax deductible contributions, ie AUMC.

If you make donations to AUMC and qualify to make QCC, you could save income taxes on your AUMC Qualified Charitable Contributions. It is possible to set QCC donations on any time schedule you prefer (weekly, monthly, etc) to meet your pledge and/or for special giving. Consult your financial advisor or tax advisor for information about how you can make your contributions to AUMC without reporting those distributions as income on your tax return.

"Love" is a theme seen throughout the month of February, but it doesn't mean much unless we put it into action. As Christians, we have the perfect example of love in action: God sending his only Son, Jesus, to die for our sins and rise again to give us new life.




God, who is love (1 John 4:8), calls his followers to love one another as he has loved us (John 15:12). That includes people of different skin colors, cultural backgrounds, physical abilities, and even religious beliefs. Kids notice differences and may be unsure how to treat people. But no matter a person's appearance or situation, Jesus loves and values him or her, and he calls us to do the same.

As parents, you play an important role in teaching your children how to love others in both word and action. Here are some helpful tips to follow.

- Acknowledge the differences that kids notice in people, and allow them to explore those differences
- Encourage children to look for positive qualities in others. Focus on what
 makes each person special and unique. Kids who feel secure in themselves are
 more likely to embrace other people with love.
- Be a role model of love and acceptance. If you want your kids to express love, you need that same approach yourself. As your role model, remember Jesus, who befriended outsiders and outcasts.


