WORD FROM THE PASTOR

²³ Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews 10:23-25

Note about finances for 2022

Here is an update from the finance side of the church as of June 30, 2022:

Total contributions for general expenses year to date	\$125,833
Total general budget expenses year to date	<u>\$140,473</u>
Net contributions over expenses year to date	(\$14,640)

Other notes:

In response to the deficit, the budget has been thoroughly tightened. Payroll, building and insurance costs YTD at June 30, 2022 were covered by current donations and all other expenses came out of cash reserves from the previous year. The Unified Board voted to delay paying our mission shares for the first half of the year. The only money that has been paid toward mission shares is from individual donors who have designated their check to go toward the mission shares. We hope to be able to catch up with mission shares in the third quarter.

Upcoming big budget items that need to be planned for is a new server for the church computer operating system and new computers to replace outdated ones that will no longer support current updates in programs like Word, Excel, etc. We have not investigated the bid process for the new computers needed but the new server will be approximately \$8,000-10,000. In addition, last year, the Administrative Board looked into upgrading the technology that is used in both sanctuaries. The bids for this are coming in around \$35,000-45,000.

Several ideas have been discussed at Unified Board meetings as to how we will accomplish all of this and right now we are thinking of having a capital campaign for the technology needs.

The most important part of this message is a thank you to those who pledge, give in the plate on Sundays or through online donations, or volunteer to do work around the church that would otherwise have to be hired out. We appreciate all that our members and regular attenders do to further the work of God through Andover United Methodist Church. Our great programs will continue with each of our support.
