Six members of AUMC attended the Problems Assembly where it was decided to continue the focus on the Homeless and the establishment of Second Light (formally called the MAC in Wichita) and affordable housing. By the time this newsletter comes out, the City of Wichita's City Council will have voted on a one cent sales tax which Justice Together is advocating for 10 million of that to go toward the affordable housing fund. We also voted to add "Gun Violence" as our third focus for the 2026 Nehemiah Assembly.

The next meeting of Justice Together will be on Thursday, March 26 at First UMC in Wichita at 6:00 pm where we will hear the reports of the research committee at the Solutions Briefing. Finally, mark your calendar for the 2026 Nehemiah Assembly which will be on Thursday, April 30 at 6:00 pm.
