WORD FROM THE PASTOR

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. ² They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³ but when they went in, they did not find the body. ⁴ While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. ⁵ The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Luke 24:1-5

The question the angels asked the women is an interesting one, "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" Often we talk about the resurrection of Jesus in how it connects us to enteral life. This hope is true and there is more to it than that. We don't have to wait until death to experience new life in Christ. At times it can feel like we are not truly alive. Technically we are not dead, our heart is beating and lungs are working but we feel dead inside. The amazing power of healing and resurrection we find in Christ calls us to life, to hope, to joy. This Easter I invite you to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, the gift of grace and love of God, and the knowledge that we can know those gifts today.

The Annual Andover **United Methodist** Rummage sale












Everyone deserves a safe place to sleep, yet there are more than 600 homeless individuals in Wichita on any given night.
