Unified Board Report

Since the year more than half-way over, the Unified Board wanted to report on how we are doing on the goals we set last December for 2023. Our first goal was to practice radical hospitality by making our church members be welcoming to new guests and to have our building be a welcoming place. To this end, we are working on a training for radical hospitality that will be happening in October, continuing to contact new guests to inform them about the events going on in the church, and completing the installation of the new technology in the sanctuary. Installation should be complete by the beginning of the school year. We also ask, if you have ideas of ways we can make our building more inviting, please contact any member of the Unified Board.

Our second goal is to promote membership in small groups. One way we have done this is by reporting in the Sunday bulletin and in "This Just In" e-newsletter what each adult Sunday School class is studying. Small groups aren't just limited to Sunday School. There are also opportunities to join the choir or the praise band, join a Bible study on Wednesday nights or Tuesday mornings, go to youth group or children's Wednesday night events, or join our newest group of "Senior Singles." We also track attendance with the hope of having at least 60% of the people who come to worship also attend a small group gathering. When we did a quick look at the numbers, we are around 70% of our regular worship attenders are also involved in at least one small group. The board has heard from the young adult age group that they would like to see a group dedicated to them. Watch for that group in the near future! We hope if you haven't found a small group, that you try one out. Or, if you have an idea for one that you would like to see started, please contact any member of the Unified Board with your idea.

Our third goal is to connect with our community and we have done that through children's programs at Easter and VBS, youth mission trips, an adult mission trip, and the symphony in the park. Coming up in the fall, be sure to mark your calendar for the GAD parade on Saturday, Sept. 30th, and walk in the parade with our church float.

The fourth goal is in the area of mission work where we are more than half-way to our goal of 8,000 service hours. We continue to pack lunches for the homeless once per month for United Methodist Open Door ministries, and we are supporting 20 students' educational costs to attend elementary school in Zimbabwe. And of course, many of our members donate and volunteer at the Andover Community Food Bank. In addition, the Women's group has collected snacks for Sunshine House and continues to collect pop tops for Ronald McDonald house.

Our fifth goal is to be involved with social justice issues. We had a speaker come out from Kansas Appleseed to learn about food insecurity in Butler County and we are continuing to participate in the DART group that is working on developing a plan to identify and address a need in the Wichita area. Watch for more information coming out in August and September about how you can attend a DART listening session to help identify an area of need that can be addressed.

The Unified Board meetings are on the 4th Monday of each month at 6:30 pm in the parlor and are open to anyone who wants to attend. If you have ideas or concerns, please contact any board member. 
