WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Happy April Andover!

During Lent, we recited the apostle's creed together in worship. This creed holds some of the foundational beliefs of the Christian faith. God created everything. Jesus is the son of God who redeems everything. The Holy Spirit is sent to equip the church. The creed doesn't line out all of the Christian faith. One of the lessons for confirmation this year was to read through the creed and see what is missing. They listed things like Jesus' miracles, our call to help people, worship and youth group, prayer, acts of kindness. We let the confirmands know that those things that stood our are not irrelevant because they are not in the creed. Rather, those things are essential to them as the strive to live out the creed. God's creation, Jesus' redemption, and the Holy Spirit's equipping is experienced and understood differently by all of us. What we notice that is missing is the way we personally feel called to be a Christian. I invite you to do the same. Reflect on the words written as well as the ways you feel called to live that helps the creed become the foundation of faith.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth;

And in Jesus Christ his only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried;* the third day he rose from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.

>>> UNIFIED BOARD

One of the goals of the Unified Board is to encourage our congregation to get involved in social justice issues. This is not an idea resting in politics, just in our efforts to get at the root cause of some issues. In order to do this we joined other United Methodist Churches (and other denominations) in the new group called "Justice Together." We had listening sessions to learn what issues were most important to our congregation, shared our results with the wider group and then voted on what 2 issues we wanted the group to tackle. The 2 issues that were chosen were homelessness and mental health. Once those issues were chosen, small groups have been meeting with experts and doing research on how best to solve the problems.

On Thursday, April 11, there will be a "Solutions Rally" where we will hear about what the small groups have discovered about how best to help make the 2 issues better for those involved. All are invited to the rally which is at First UMC in Wichita at 6:00 pm.

The next date to put on your calendar is the Nehemiah Assembly on May 11 at 6:00 pm probably being held at Century II. At that meeting we will present the solution ideas to our elected officials. It is the hope that 2,000 people from area churches will be in attendance. It is our goal to have 30 people from AUMC attend the Nehemiah Rally. Please help us meet that goal by marking it on your calendar.
