WORD FROM THE PASTOR

²⁴ Do you not know that in a race the runners all compete, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win it. ²⁵ Athletes exercise self-control in all things; they do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable one. ²⁶ So I do not run aimlessly, nor do I box as though beating the air; ²⁷ but I punish my body and enslave it, so that after proclaiming to others I myself should not be disgualified. *1 Corinthains* 9:24-27

I have always loved the Olympics. Did you know that the Olympics inspire scripture? Well, not exactly. The idea of games and competition that occurred in Rome and Greece that were the basis for what we know as the Olympic games also give Paul an analogy to send to the church in Corinth, Greece about why he lives a disciplined life. Paul notes earlier in the chapter that nothing is forbidden from him as it had when he understood his faith from the traditional Jewish view point. In Christ, though, he and everyone is free. This freedom is used to connect with others so that as Paul says, "For though I am free with respect to all, I have made myself a slave to all, so that I might win more of them." Therefore, while he is free he lives a disciplined life of service to connect with others so they may know Jesus' love. Paul compares his life to the discipline of an athlete. Think how much time, focus, desire, and energy goes towards competing in the Olympic games. Paul notes that if the athletes will strive so hard for a perishable crown, we should strive as hard for the imperishable one we receive from Christ Jesus. Paul will live his life with purpose towards living out his faith.

I invite you this August to both enjoy the Olympic games and consider how you are running the race of your own faith. I encourage you in the race and encourage you to reach out if you feel like, for what ever reason you are struggling. All athletes have trainers and coaches to help and we are no different with our faith. The joy of a faith community is that we don't run the race of faith alone but with those we worship, serve, and fellowship with.

Let us run our race of faith together for the imperishable wreath found in Christ Jesus
