WORD FROM THE PASTOR

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. ² They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³ but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴ While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. ⁵ In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead?

Luke 24:1-5

Happy April and Happy Easter! I love the line "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" The angles are stating a fact that Jesus is risen and thus He wouldn't be in a tomb. If the women are trying to find Jesus they need to look out in the world not a grave. In fact, Mary Magdalene will encounter Jesus in the garden as the other women rush to tell the disciples. I also think the line can be used beyond just the fact Jesus is risen to apply to the way we live out our faith. We are to be resurrection people, people of new life and hope. To know the grace of Jesus it so know the call of forgiveness to live those actions, activities, and times of away from God and embrace the new life walking with Jesus. Sin can be defined as missing the mark and in the grace of Jesus we are able to correct our path to be the person God has called us to be.

The time of Lent and the sacrifices we made were intended to prepare us to move out of the darkness and live with Jesus in the Light. After Easter we will often stop those pactices and sacrifices. I encourage you to continue you seeking out spiritual practices and fasting. No, you don't have to give up sweets forever, but what are things that you could regularly fast? How could you add a moment of prayer in your day? Is there a cause that you could volunteer to help with? The angles told the women that if they want to find Jesus they need to look among the living. I invite us as resurrection people to look for Jesus in a faith that is alive engaging with God and the world.
